# Role of EV



## ➤ **Ex-post evaluation**

- ✓ Evaluate projects usually after 1 year of operation.

## ➤ **Objective**

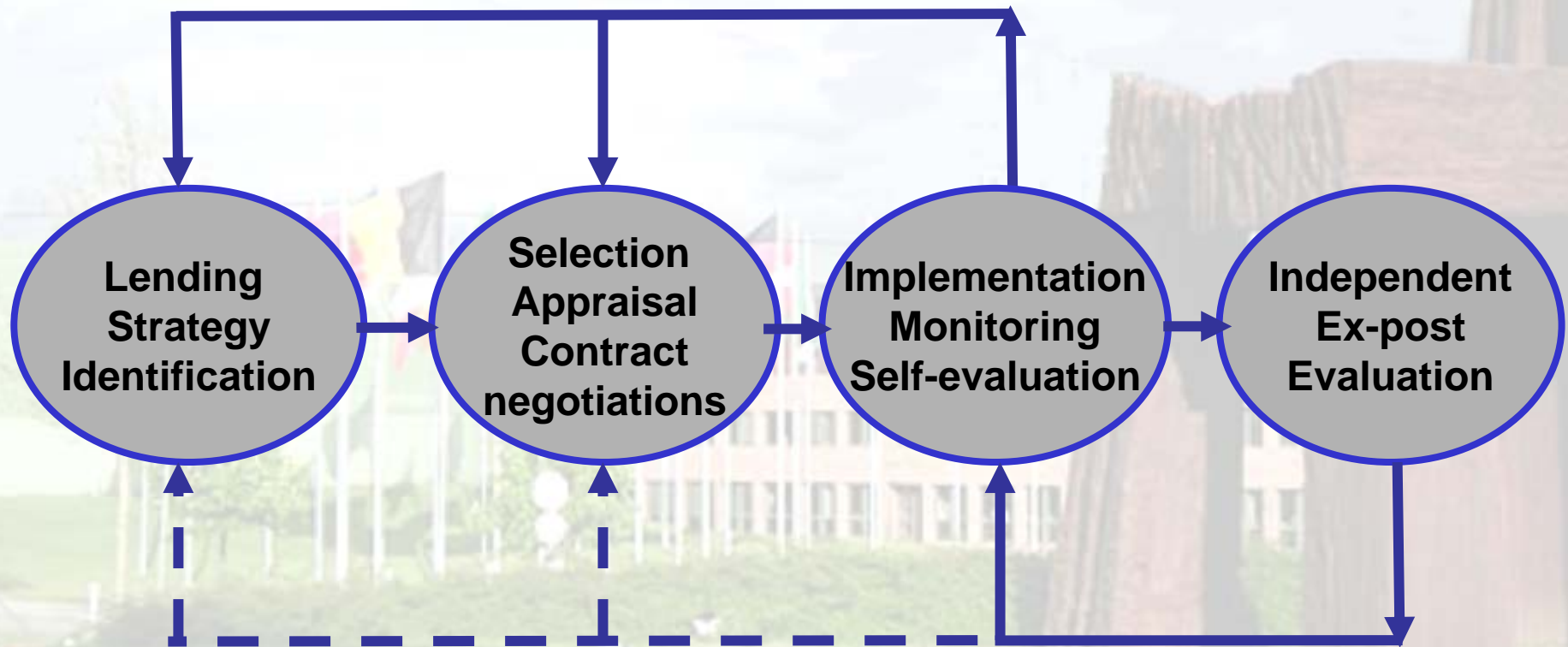
- ✓ Improved operational performance
- ✓ Accountability
- ✓ Transparency

## ➤ **Partnership:**

- With the European Commission
- With other Financial Institutions (ECG group, bilateral institutions etc.)

- **Relevance**
- **Project Performance**
  - ✓ Effectiveness
  - ✓ Efficiency
  - ✓ Sustainability
  - ✓ Environmental and Social Performance
- **EIB contribution**
- **EIB management of the project cycle**



# ESI AF - an evaluation perspective



- EV involved in the preparation of the new framework.
- Key evaluation criteria reflected.
- Ex-ante assessment of ESI AF
  - benchmark for self-evaluation & ex-post assessment
  - ensures consistency throughout the project cycle.

# **E** Indicator standardisation



- **Evaluation Cooperation Group (ECG) – strengthen the use of evaluation for greater effectiveness and accountability, share lessons, harmonize performance indicators/evaluation methodologies and approaches.**
- **ECG has progressed on key good practice standards (GPS) for evaluation.**
- **IFI's have different objectives, reflected also in evaluation criteria (i.e development outcome <- > transition impact, additionality etc.).**



# Future



- **Too early to draw lessons for EV, but use in ex-post evaluations as reference.**
- **Mid-term review of new external 2007-2013 mandates.**
- **Increased emphasis on joint evaluations (EBRD, KfW, AFD etc.) to increase collaboration.**
